1966 Monterey GP Ed Leslie driver. 9th.

To Richard Gamboni Oakland California. 1966 - 1968.

Ed leslie drove for him. did not run in 1967 as re built with 327 Chevy and Huffaker transmission.

the rear suspension was converted to trailing arm (which is still has today ) by Nate Bourgeault of Mill Valey.
