Hey Jon, Dustin had to leave a bit early today, so photos will arrive in your E-mail tomorrow. I am delighted w/ the outcome...car porn. I am planning to ship on Monday, so that I can properly palletize over the weekend, and not have the chassis sit on a dock over the weekend. This is a very busy chassis, but the most advanced spaceframe of the era. The E-7 has the highest torsional rigidity value of all of it's peers. That is why it is easy to drive fast, and is so responsive to minor changes in shocks and ARB's. You will get the best shipping rate if we prepay, rather than freight collect. We use YRC, as they rarely damage anything, and freely pay damage claims (highly unusual). We generally get a quote, then an adjustment that makes the rate increase. It is what it is, but it will be, while expensive, much cheaper than freight collect. Cheers, Mate! Pat
