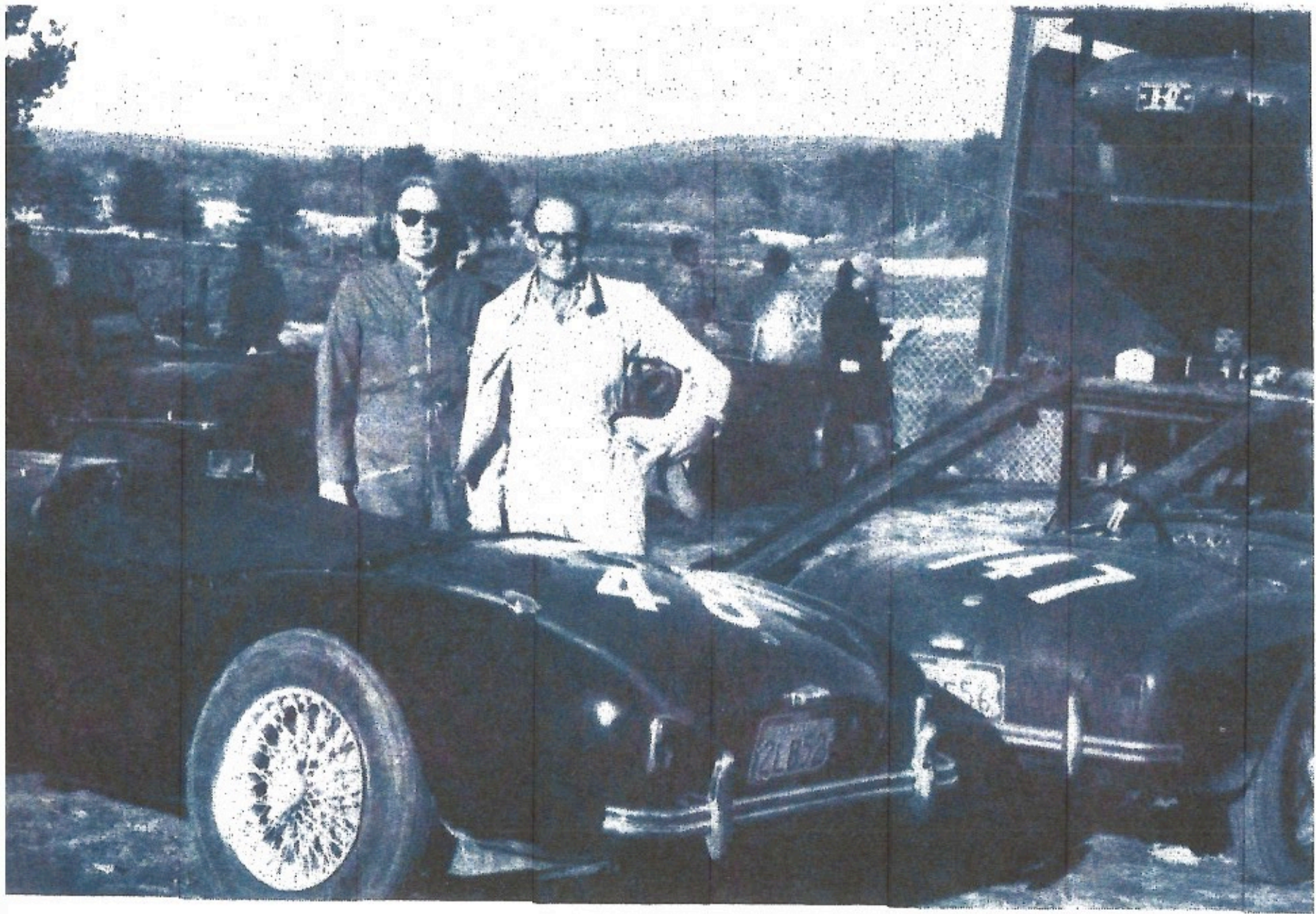

Again we so enjoyed seeing you and the car at Beaver Creek. We are hoping you will come to Santa Fe at some point and meet more of the family.

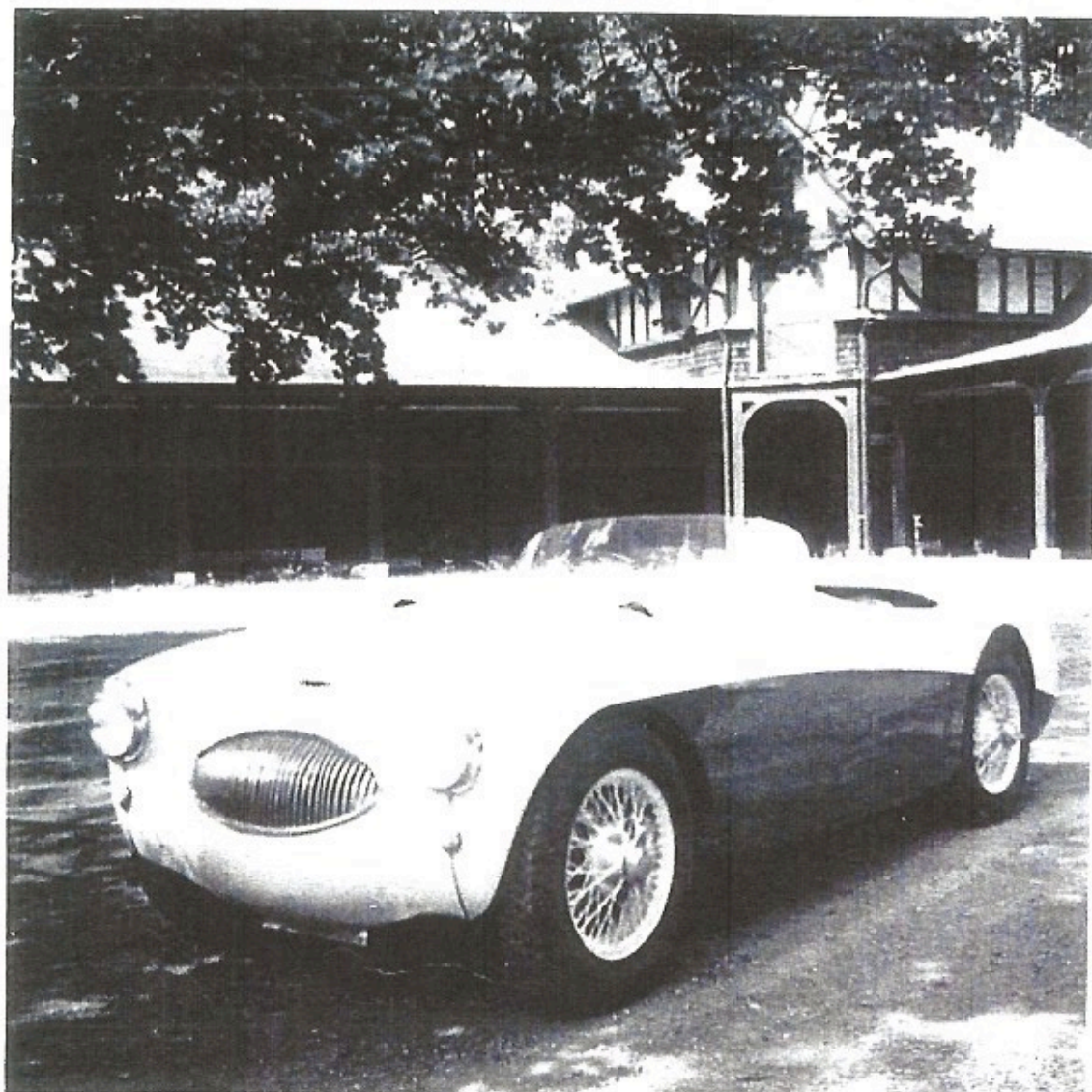
