MAHLON F. CRAFT

Various documents supplied by Peter Fisk who sold my 1963 1000 Monomille GT sn# 110-0380 to me as having been previous owners of the car. All show the serial number of a" Fiat 2 door coupe: 1586414". In fact, this number is the serial number of the original Abarth "AH" 1000 cc pushrod cylinder block that came with the car and is in the car now having been fitted with an Abarth twin-cam (Bialbero) cylinderhead. The number is obscured by the chain-case for the twin-cam head, but can be verified by using a small inspection mirror.

The paper chain of ownership goes back to William Gaard, reportedly the first owner of the car. The paperwork indicates it was registered for street use. This is supported by an original registration sticker that is still on the windshield.

Mr Gaard is reported to have bought the car new from Alfred Cosentino of FAZA fame who apparently imported the car from Abarth.

Audi's hand-built stormer was a sensation when it first appeared—Paul Lienert said then, "at a retail price of \$35,000, it's tough to find a competitor in the U.S. that stacks up to the Audi" (*AutoWeek*, June 7, 1982). But the storm has played out. With Audi putting its four-wheel-drive philosophy to work in more mainstream efforts like the 4000 Quattro and the new 5000 turbo version, the original has found only 59 U.S. homes so far this year. And if you think the 4000S Quattro car we positively adore—is much better seller, think again. Audi had sold just over 2,500 through July.

WINNER

Honda CRX Si

Even before the Si appeared, we knew the CRX was as hot as they come. Now buyers are waiting months for the quick version. Honda's slick little two-seat commuter, making it *Waiting List's* Car of the Year. Dutch Mandel described the Si as being both "cute and fierce" (*AutoWeek*, April 22, 1985).

And how many have actually been taken home and fed by kind enthusiasts with a penchant for fun? About 19,500 from mid-February through August. Si sales are responsible for half of total CRX sales, which in turn take up just over 10 percent of Honda's total sales (367,000 cars) here.

WINNER

Toyota MR2

Though it would have been difficult to make a wrong call, the automotive press got it right when it said Toyota would sell all the MR2s it could send over.

We loved it. West Coast editor Dutch Mandel commented, "Talk about the old sports car urge: The MR2's high-revving twin-cam engine is sweet and responsive" (*AutoWeek*, Dec. 10, 1984).

The public has responded. Toyota sold selling 24,417 of them over the last eight months—and would doubtless have sold many more if not for quotas.

WINNER

Honda Accord

Honda's Accord has the top spot, as the best selling import in the U.S., beating Nissan's Sentra by 50,000 units sold to date. Of course, if you're a dyed-in-the-wool import fan then the Sentra wins outright.

Why? Because more than half of the Accords being sold here in 1985 are home-grown in Marysville, Ohio. Picky, picky, picky. The innards, and the outards too, are Japanese, no matter where the little beauties are welded up. Besides which, Nissan has begun assembling Sentras down in Tennessee, so the whole leading import duel is getting a little silly.
