After inspecting the Cheetah, identified by the number BTC003 on the front cross-member, and currently owned by Mr. Fred Yeakel, my opinion is that this car is one of the original Bill Thomas Cheetahs produced by Bill Thomas Race Cars in 1964.

I, Allen R Grant, was the driver of the 1964 Bill Thomas Cheetah raced by Alan Green Chevrolet during the 1964 and 1965 racing seasons. As the driver, I participated in 10 races during the period from May 10, 1964 (USRRC at Pacific Raceways) through October 18, 1964 (Monterey Grand Prix at Laguna Seca). I was also involved in the preparation and maintenance of the Cheetah during that time period. Drum brakes were on the Cheetah when I was involved with the car.

After inspecting the Cheetah, identified by the number BTC003 on the front cross-member, and currently owned by Mr. Fred Yeakel, my opinion is that this is the same Bill Thomas Cheetah which I drove for Alan Green Chevrolet during the 1964 racing season and for which I was responsible as described above.

Drum brakes were on the Cheetah during the time that Alax Green Chevrolet had the car.

In May 1972 I purchased the ex Alan Green Chevrolet racing Cheetah, built by Bill Thomas Race Cars of Anaheim California, from Barrington M Grant. There was no serial number or ID number. Barrington Grant did not have a serial number. When the frame was stripped and powder coated, no ID # was found. In the 1970's and early 80's, I contacted who ever I could about the production number of the car. Bill Thomas did not respond to my inquiry. From the research I did, I had to surmise that Jerry Grant, driver for Alan Green Chevrolet, got the third car. Therefore, BTC003 was chosen as the ID # at that time and placed on the square front cross member.

I always enjoy watching your car vintage race because it was so extensively raced in-period from 1964-1966 while owned by Alan Green Chevrolet. During that time, this car was driven by Allen Grant, Don Jensen and Gary Gove in events both in the USA and Canada. The documentation you have supporting the original race campaign and the subsequent ownership and vintage racing career of this car is outstanding.

Your Cheetah is marked with the number BTC003 on the front cross-member.
