I have known Everett Duncan since 1962 when we brought our Spirit of America I jet car to the Quincy D. Epperly Company, Race Car Engineering and Fabrication at 13509 So. Raymond in Gardena, California, where we built the body in preparation for the World Land Speed Record which we established at the Bonneville Salt Flats in Utah on August 5, 1963 with a speed of 407.45 mph.
