This Ferrari GTS was sent to Milan, Italy where in 1998-1999 it underwent an entire mechanical and cosmetic restoration. Before its departure, the transaxle was rebuilt by Nereo Iori the chief racing mechanic of Luiti Chinetti's North American Racing Team (NART). Paolo Vaccari and ex NART race mechanic was responsible for coordinating the entire restoration project in Italy. The mechanical restoration including rebuilding the engine, suspension, brakes, cooling system and other related work was completed at Gianni Regiani's shop by Paolo Viccari. After removing all the necessary mechanical components from the car to be rebuilt, Paolo made arrangements to deliver the body to Bachelli & Villa, owners of Carrozzeria Auto Sport. The body was then stripped to the bare metal and paint was applied. The body was then shipped back to Gianni Regiani's shop where all the mechanical and electrical components were reinstalled. The entire interior was prepared at Lupi in Modena and was installed by Lupi at Gianni Regiani's shop.
